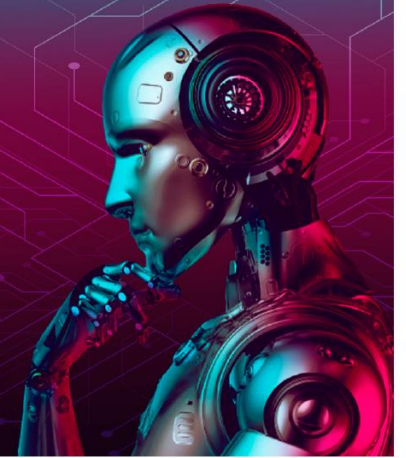


Legal Evolution: Analytics and Artificial Intelligence in the Law
