Kara Brodfuehrer is a Senior Counsel with the California Civil Rights Department (CRD)'s Education and Outreach Unit where she focuses on educating Californians about their rights under the laws enforced by CRD, including the Fair Employment and Housing Act. Before joining CRD, Kara worked on state and federal housing policy and was also Senior Attorney at the Law Foundation of Silicon Valley's Mental Health Advocacy Project representing low-income tenants with disabilities. Kara started her legal career at California Rural Legal Assistance Inc., where she focused on improving public infrastructure, fair housing, and promoting environmental justice in disadvantaged unincorporated communities.
